- <u>Rumford Rifle Range</u> Wayne reported that the Rumford Rifle Range munition study and remediation project is underway, and he will follow up with Weston Consultants on project status.
- <u>Planning Director</u> Wayne reported that long-time Planning Director Jeanne Boyle has resigned and has accepted a position with the City of Pawtucket.

- <u>Marjorie Turner</u> Ms. Turner has requested a letter of support from the Commission for her forthcoming trail guide "Easy Walks in the Ten Mile River Watershed." - Ernie reported that the Providence Country Day School hike at Hunt's Mill was cancelled on April 21 due to rain.
- Ernie also reported that a June 11 Great Outdoors day is planned at Hunt's Mills.
- Wayne reported that he had visited the National Grid utility clearing along Veteran's Parkway and noted it still needs attention and will contact them for corrective action.
- Keith reported that herring count at Hunt's Mill fish ladder this season was low compared to previous years and was likely a result of a very warm February that had fish migrating early and were missed by observers. He also noted the late March fish kill along the Turner Reservoir in mid-April.
