The City of East Providence Rhode Island is requesting proposals from highly qualified financial institutions for the purpose of obtaining a full range of depository and banking services at a competitive price. The period of the agreement shall be for the five year period beginning November 1, 2021 and ending October 31, 2026. The bids will be publicly recorded. Bids received with a time of 11:01 AM or later will be rejected.

All written questions must be received by Monday, September 20, 2021 at 3:00 PM. The answers to questions received will be answered on an issued addendum and posted to the City's website as well as emailed to the potential bidding vendors who have sent their Electronic Bid Notification Form.
