Questions and Information Requested during the Sweetened House Contractor Walk Through on 9/9/2022

Question and Answers

- Q) Please provide species of door.
- A) Door type A and C to be birch. Door type B to be pine.
- Q) Confirm toilet accessories needed for ADA Lav (120)
- A) The only accessory required is a 12 in. x 12 in. pass-through with a stainless steel body and wall flanges, stainless steel hardware, and a mechanical interlock allowing only one door to be open at a time. No trim needed.
- Q) Are any toilet accessories at sinks in Medical Exam Rooms?
- A) No toilet accessories is needed at sinks in medical exam rooms.
- Q) Is there a basis of design for the Entry/Lobby (101) windows (1S & 1W)?
- A) Rough openings will be trimmed with Select Kiln-Dried Square Edge Whitewood Board 1 in. x Pine flush to walls. Casings around openings will be 1 in. x 3 in. of same material with a ¼ in. reveal.
- Q) What level of finish is required at new partitions?
- A) Sheetrock taped and spackled with level 4 finish.
- Q) Is the dishwasher provided and installed by the general contractor?
- A) No

- Q) Are any bonds required for the project?
- A) A 100% Performance Bond and Certificate of General Liability insurance coverage of \$1 million as well as Workers Compensation Insurance as required by the state of Rhode Island for itself and any of its employees.
- Q) Is a builder's risk insurance policy required?
- A) No
- Q) Will one contractor be chosen for all three projects (general construction, structural repairs and area investigation).
- A) Yes
- Q) Can all three projects be completed at the same time?
- A) Yes

Clarifications

- 1) Remove stair railing and bottom step to stairs in passageway opposite entrance to room 111. Frame access and relocate sprinkler head within hallway.
- 2) The city will not require engineering plans for the design build HVAC system.
- 3) Permit fees will be waived by city.
- 4) Carpeting to be equal to or higher than Patcraft, product collection: Beyond the Door. Specifications equal to or higher than:

- 5) Reception sliding window off lobby can be vinyl.
- 6) Wall repairs/patches can be done with sheet rock material, taped & spackled with level 4 finish.
- 7) Medical exam rooms sinks to be equal or greater than Houzer Club Series, steel 18-Gauge, T-304 premium stainless steel, and meet ASME A112.19.3-2000, UPC, CSA
- 8) Medical exam room sink faucets to be equal or greater than Pfister, Ladera single hole polished chrome.
- 9) Medical exam room counter tops can be Formica laminate sheet.
- 10) Medical exam cabinets to be equal or greater than Hampton Bay, 1 drawer, 2 bi-parting doors, 1 half-depth adjustable shelf, plain finish, and assembled.
