I. GENERAL

The City of East Providence (City) requests proposals from qualified Vendors to install a Ducted Interior Heating & Cooling System as detailed in this Request for Bids. General requirements of the Proposals are below:

- All equipment/material to be supplied shall comply with the specifications detailed in Section II of this Request for Bids. Any equipment/material proposed outside of these specifications will need prior written approval by Andrew Baum.
- Bids shall include estimated delivery and installation times.

II. SPECIFICATION

- Install Five Ton Hydro Air Fan Coil with A/C Install new 5 ton Hydro Air System in offices and sign shop.
- Equipment Spec
- Aspen AHU model# ASP-AFM614-WC4LL
- Bryant two stage condenser Model# 113AWA0600L0 or equivalent with approval from Public Buildings HVAC Andrew Baum — contact info (401) 302-1665 or abaum@eastprovidenceri.gov.
- Place condenser in front of building next to existing Dakin Split A/C
 - Install new air handler in ceiling above sign shop
 - Remove existing heater in sign shop and use hot water feed and return to supply hot water to hydro coil.

- Install & provide power to all associated equipment
- 120 volt for Ahu 15 amp
- 208/230 volt 30 amp circuit condenser
- Connect to fire alarm shut down if necessary
- Install mixing box for fresh air duct, flash and seal completely
- Connect A/C tubing between AHU and condenser
- Pipe condensate drains to outdoors or plumbing
- Supply & install new duct, grills, diffusers, and return grills as needed
- Insulate all necessary duct and piping
- Pressure test system, vacuum, and charge accordingly. Contractor to provide start-up reports.
- Unit should have capability of BMS system when installed.
- All work to be performed by Qualified Licensed Technicians following local code, manufacturer's specs, and best trade practices. All building penetration to be sealed and flashed water tight.
